RED BRICKS

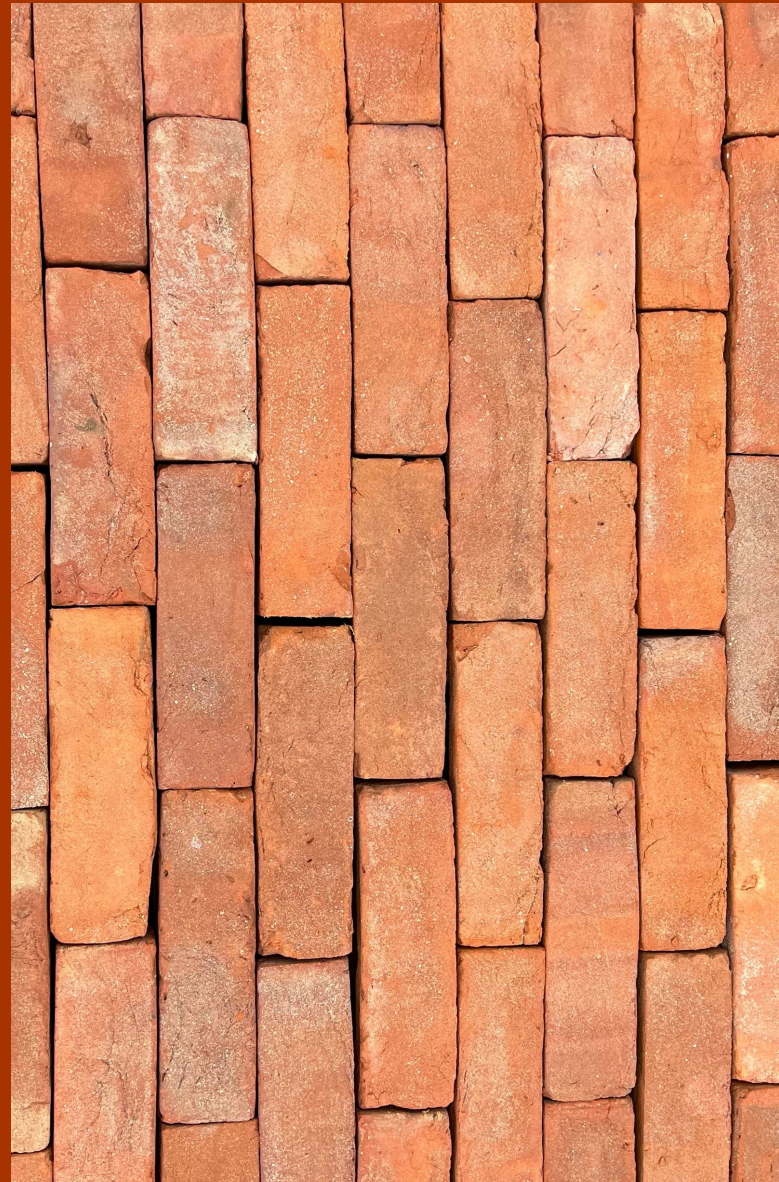

INDIAN RED BRICKS

The distinct reddish-brown color comes from the iron content in the clay, which oxidizes during the firing process.



Characteristics:

Texture: They usually have a somewhat rough and porous texture, contributing to their traditional aesthetic.

Durability: When properly fired, red bricks are highly durable, resistant to weathering, and have excellent compressive strength, making them suitable for load-bearing walls.

Thermal Properties: They offer good thermal insulation, helping to keep interiors cool in hot climates and warm in colder ones.

Visually, they have a rustic charm due to variations in texture and slight imperfections, creating a dynamic, multi-toned facade when used in construction.

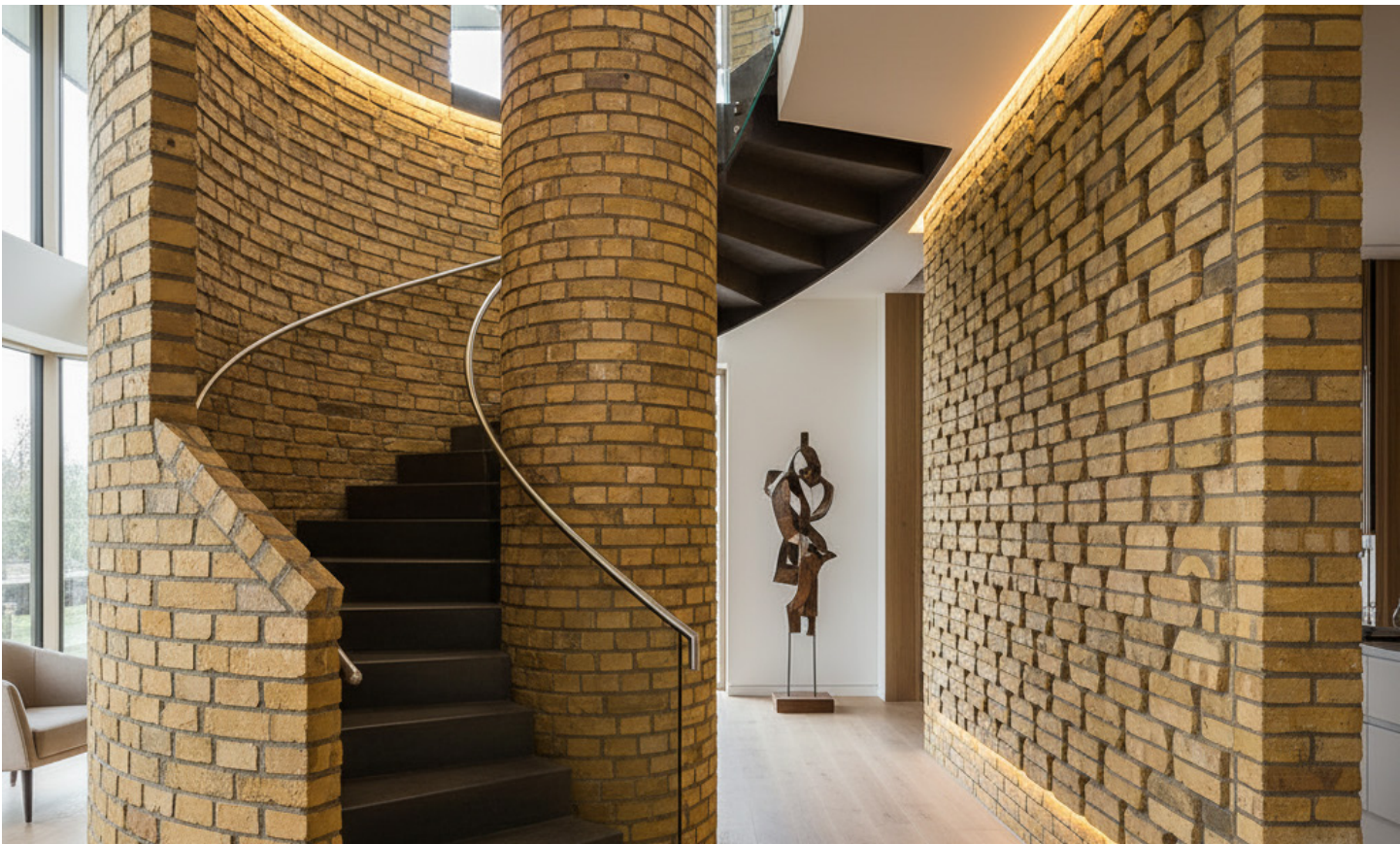
